Cerys Jones trained at the Royal College of Music and the Juilliard School of Music, and has performed as a chamber musician and Section Leader in the most prestigious venues worldwide.

Cerys appears regularly as a Section Principal with many UK orchestras, including BBC National Orchestra of Wales, Royal Northern Sinfonia, Welsh National Opera, Manchester Camerata, and she has a very close association as a Guest Principal with Royal Liverpool Philharmonic Orchestra.

Cerys is a member of the acclaimed Sinfonia of London, and their Korngold disc was voted BBC Music Magazine Album of 2020.

During her time with the Heath Quartet, Cerys performed and broadcast worldwide in venues such as Carnegie Hall, Wigmore Hall, Concertgebouw and Berlin Konzerthaus, and the quartet were awarded the RPS Young Artist Award amongst other accolades. Cerys has recorded Gramophone Award-winning CDs of Bartok, Tippett, and Tchaikovsky for Harmonia Mundi and Wigmore Live, as well as appearing as a soloist on recordings, performing Saint-Saens and Judith Weir.

Cerys teaches at both the Royal Welsh College of Music and Drama, and at the Guildhall School of Music and Drama.
