Jeff Stewart studied at the Guildhall School of Music and Drama, winning the Harold Rosenthal Award for outstanding achievement, and then at the National Opera Studio.

In an extensive international Opera and concert career, Jeff has sung over 60 operatic roles covering a very wide variety of styles and genres. He has now settled into dramatic tenor repertoire and made his debut as Peter Grimes to high critical acclaim in 2014. He has appeared at the Royal Opera House, Covent Garden, English National Opera, Opera North, Opera Holland Park, Opera Northern Ireland, Castleward Opera, Deutsche Oper am Rhein, Düsseldorf, Komische Oper, Berlin, Bremen, Schwerin and Gera and Coburg, as well as the Macedonian National Opera.

Jeff has also sung all over the world in concerts including *The Dream of Gerontius* in South Africa, *Carmina Burana* in Beijing and Mozart's *Missa Domenico* in the USA. He has appeared at all London's major concert venues.
