Mark David Boden studied with Ken Hesketh at the Royal College of Music where he graduated with Distinction from the MMus course in Advanced Composition.

His music has been commissioned by a varied range of ensembles including BBC National Orchestra of Wales, London Philharmonic Orchestra, Hebrides Ensemble, Bath Abbey Choir, Sinfonia Cymru and Camerata Nordica, in addition to the ABRSM Spectrum series.

Numerous orchestral works have been broadcast on BBC Radio 3 including *Six Degrees, Fuochi Distanti* and *Ghyll* in addition to several works for voices including *Siegfried Stanzas* and *Homo Sum*.

Mark's choral work *Awake Glad Heart* opened the Christmas Day broadcast by the BBC Symphony Chorus on BBC Radio 3. His music has been performed across Europe by musicians such as Quatour Tana (Belgium), Nexus Reed Quintet (Switzerland) and violinist Bartosz Woroch (Poland). He recently collaborated with children's author Catherine Bruton on the musical *POP!* which premiered in Bath.
